Dear mother -

Ed and J., Alg and I
showed my letter as we rode
with the children up to the
draw bridge on Friday afternoon.

There we stopped and had a
most thrilling and successful
afternoon crabbing. It was
the first expedition I've had
this year. We had a very long

variations of work and big all along
the row of crabs.

Ed J. came over in the evening and
he shows us then what out. He said that
one and prepared the rest to be done.

I suppose Alg and Tom are on their
way to Buffalo by this time. They expect to get
back to Phils from Kansas City next
day noon. We expect to see him down here
again a week from tonight or tomorrow and
then I hope he will be starting for southwest
the next day. He was going to see how it

the office to-day, for him to be away from
the afternoon of the 17th till the 29th. Of
course I have ^{not} had time to hear what his
decision and plans are but he is going
to let me and Henry know just as soon
